Amendment #1 - 1st VP and 2nd VP succession in event past President is unavailable

Folsom Area Democratic Club (FADC) — Proposed Bylaws Amendment
Amendment to Article VI, Section 6 — Immediate Past President Succession

Recitals

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 6 currently provides that the Immediate Past President serves as an advisor on all Club matters and as a voting member of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Club seeks to ensure continuity and clarity when the Immediate Past President is unavailable, by establishing an orderly, temporary succession for that seat; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VIII of the FADC Bylaws, amendments may be adopted by the membership at a duly noticed meeting;

Resolved Amendment

The membership of the Folsom Area Democratic Club hereby amends Article VI, Section 6 in its entirety to read as follows:

Article VI — Officers and Board

Section 6. Immediate Past President (IPP).

The Immediate Past President of the Club shall act as an advisor on all Club matters and shall serve as a voting member of the FADC Board of Directors.

Succession if IPP is unavailable. If there is no eligible Immediate Past President, or the Immediate Past President is unable or unwilling to serve for any meeting or period during the current term (including vacancy, recusal, absence, or incapacity), the IPP seat shall be filled in the following order of succession:

- a) the Immediate Past First Vice President; and, if that person is unavailable,
- b) the Immediate Past Second Vice President.

An individual serving under this succession shall have all rights and responsibilities of the IPP seat for the relevant meeting(s) or period.

Single-vote cap. If a person serving under this Section also holds another Board position at the same time, that person is entitled to one vote only on any Board matter and shall be counted once for quorum.



Definitions. “Immediate Past First Vice President” and “Immediate Past Second Vice President” mean the most recent holders of those offices immediately preceding the current term. If an office was vacant, “immediate past” refers to the most recent prior holder.

Reference (for the record)

Current text (replaced): “Section 6. The immediate past president of the club shall act as an advisor on all Club matters and serve as a voting member on the FADC board of directors.”

New text (adopted): As set forth above in “Section 6. Immediate Past President (IPP).”

Adoption & Effective Date

This amendment shall be effective upon adoption by the membership in accordance with Article VIII of the FADC Bylaws at a duly noticed meeting. The Secretary is directed to update the master copy of the Bylaws and distribute the updated version, and to transmit it to any chartering body as required.



Exhibit B

Amendment #2 - Eliminate "Newsletter" Requirements and References

1) Article VI, Section 5(A) — Communications Chair (revise):

Amend to: "Provide communications concerning meetings, programs, and projects of the Club to the membership and other recipients as directed by the Board and/or Committee Chairs."

2) Article IV, Section 2(C) — Elections (revise):

Amend to: Replace "e-mail newsletter" with "email," so the sentence reads: "Between the September and October meetings, nominees may write an election statement to be sent in a collective special edition email by the Communications Chair to all members of the Club."

3) Article IV, Section 2(F) — Elections (revise):

Amend to: Replace "announced in the following newsletter" with "announced via the Club's official communications," so the sentence reads: "Winners of the election will be made known at the October meeting and announced via the Club's official communications."

4) Standing Rules, Item 2 — Newsletter/President's Message (delete in full):

Amend to: Delete Standing Rules, Item 2 in its entirety.
